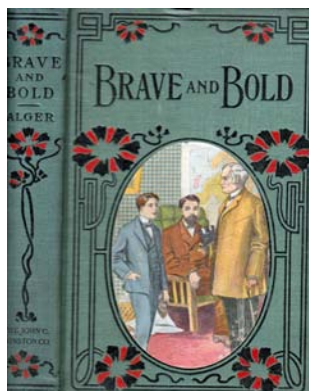

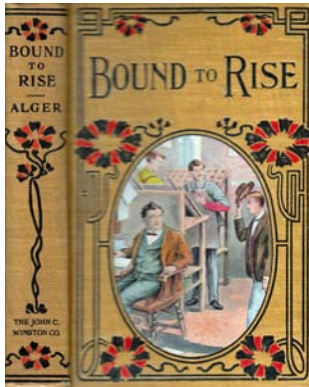
Type 2: Colored Oval Inlay



Frontice piece has colored pictures of Alger bordered by general scenes.

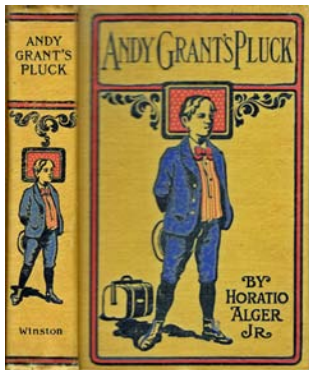


Type 2 B: Colored Oval Inlay

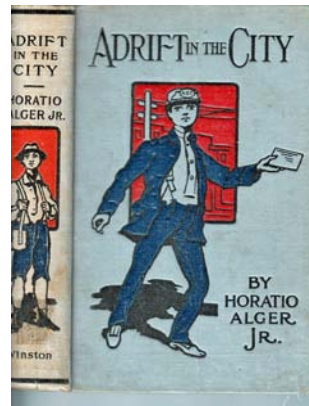

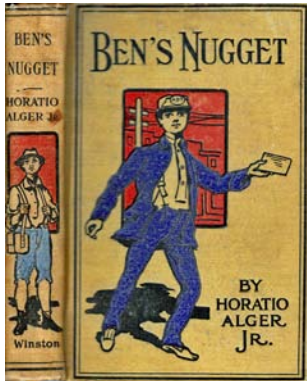

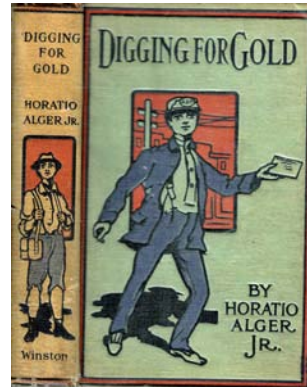

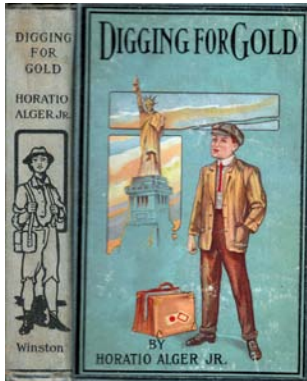
Variation A: ADT boy running with skyscraper in background.

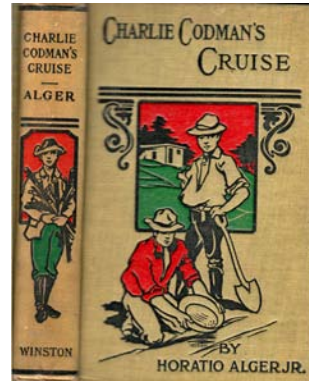

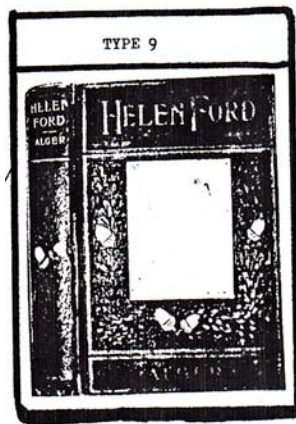


Variation D: Boy in coat and cap with suitcase on ground. Statue of Liberty in background.

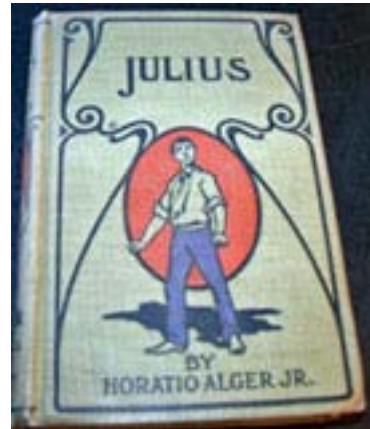

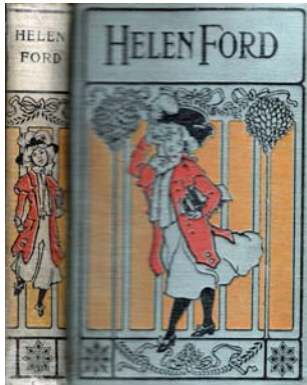

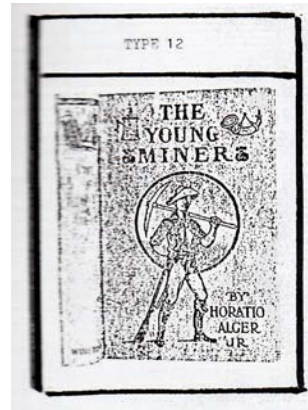

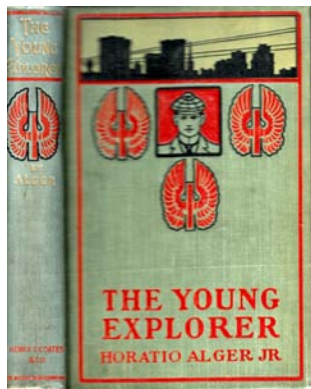

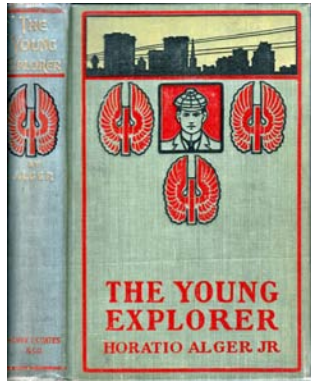

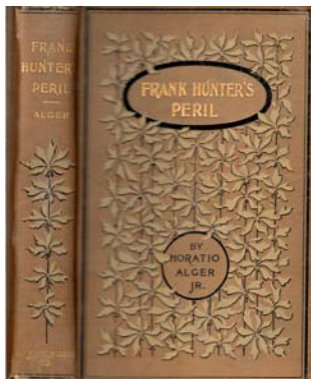

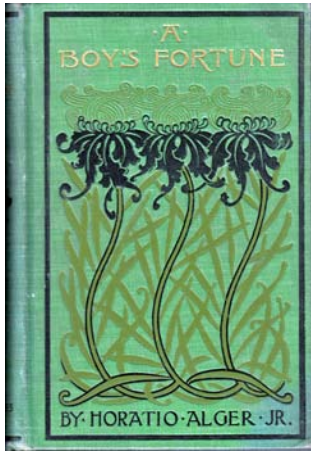

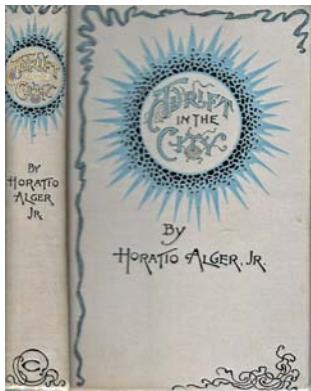

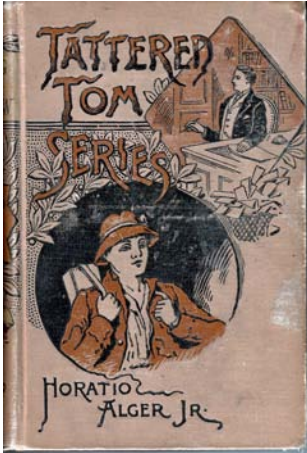

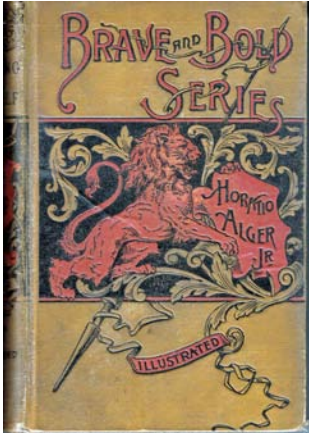
