In 1894 the Werner Printing and Lithographing Company was reorganized as The Werner Company.

In 1909 the Werner Company failed. It was purchased back on year later by Mr. Werner and some associates. They called the new company The New Werner Company which struggled along for four years, then it too went bankrupt.

This company produced only one Alger format about 1913 which is identical on the outside to the plain format produced by The MacLellan-NY Publishers a year or two earlier.
