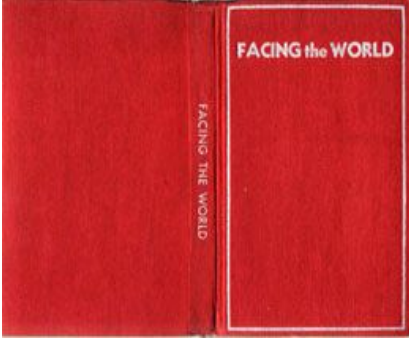

- Except for the reference to the publisher appearing on the title page these two companies produced an identical No Diamonds Format. World binding color is both red and blue; World Syndicate is only red. This format has no internal illustrations.
